

**NOTICE OF ACTION  
BY THE  
UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON**

Notice is given under SEPA, RCW 43.21.C.080, that the University of Washington took the action described in item 2 below on February 14, 2019.

1. Any action to set aside, enjoin, review or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of chapter 43.21C RCW (State Environmental Policy Act) shall be commenced on or before March 20, 2019.
2. Description of the proposed action: Board of Regents adoption of the University of Washington Seattle Campus Master Plan as amended by the Seattle City Council in Clerk File 314346 and passed as Council Bills 119246 and 119453 (Ordinances 125733 and 125763).
3. Description of proposal: Adoption of a new Campus Master Plan (CMP) for the University of Washington Seattle Campus. The CMP and accompanying SEPA documents include purpose, vision and principles; design guidance; development programs; development standards; transportation management strategies; housing; utilities; and reasonable alternatives.
4. Location of proposal: The University District area of Seattle, Washington. The campus of the University is located in Northeast Seattle. The University of Washington Major Institution Overlay Zone is generally bounded by NE 45th Street on the north; Mary Gates Memorial Way NE and the Center for Urban Horticulture on the east; Union Bay, the Lake Washington Ship Canal, and Portage Bay on the south; and the Interstate-5 Ship Canal Bridge, Roosevelt Way NE and 15th Avenue NE on the west.
5. Type of environmental review under SEPA: Final Environmental Impact Statement, University of Washington 2018 Seattle Campus Master Plan issued on July 5, 2017.
