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KEY UPCOMING EVENTS:

- 1. The Ship Canal Trail will continue to be closed off to the public through January, opening back up in July 2026.
- 2. January will see a continuation of interior structural upgrades at the roof, truss, and foundation level.
- 3. Trusses which have experienced aging and damage over the years will continue to be reset into place and structurally affixed.
- 4. January is the start of some exterior underground mechanical and electrical systems which will connect to the inside of the building after February 2026.
- 5. February will see a large amount of demolition and abatement of hazardous materials. January will start the prep work for these activates.
- 6. The building will continue to produce historic salvage material, being stored for reuse at the end of the project.
