Project Phase

Design Preconstruction: Design the project based upon the base scope, schedule and target value budget defined in Project Definition.

Goals & Objectives

- 1. Integrate: Innovative and comprehensive care, offered in a healing environment, to help patients with behavioral health recovery.
- 2. **Heal:** Alternative to existing long-term (90/180-day) civil commitment beds at Western State Hospital.
- 3. **Educate:** Training site for the next generation of health and behavioral health care providers for WA State.
- 4. **Innovate:** Support the first of its kind 24/7 365 day a year tele-psych program.
- 5. Safeguard: Ensure safe environment for patients, providers, staff, trainees and visitors.
- 6. Sustain: Project design to incorporate required infrastructure upgrades & connectivity for hospital's essential services.
- 7. **Honor:** Preserve and evolve campus vision, including how patients and visitors experience the campus.
- 8. Welcome: Provide a welcoming and healing environment that will raise public awareness about the importance of behavioral health and its impact to the health of all our families and our communities.

Project Scope

The facility must provide a minimum of fifty behavioral health long-term civil commitment beds, fifty behavioral health geriatric/ adult civil voluntary beds, and fifty licensed medical/surgery beds, with the capacity to treat patients with behavioral health needs. The project must also include a 24/7 telehealth consultation program within the facility. Additional scope includes: 1) procedural area for electroconvulsive therapy, and neuromodulation to support patients' commitment to community- based living and health care; 2) capacity to conduct comprehensive workforce training and development for behavioral health and general health care providers. Program needs to support the building include kitchen facilities, increased utility service capacity, visitor parking and amenities.
