Bothell	The project site is at the north end of the campus adjacent to Beardslee Boulevard. The current UW Bothell/Cascadia College campus is generally bounded by I-405 and SR-522 on the East; SR- 522 on the South; 110th Avenue NE and 108th Avenue NE on the West; and Beardslee Boulevard on the North.	The Husky Village Redevelopment project is being proposed in Development Area D of the campus to provide residence halls, apartments, dining, gathering, and office space. The four proposed buildings are anticipated to be approximately 300,000 gross square feet (GSF). Demolition of the existing Husky Village buildings will result in a reduction of 74,152 existing GSF. Sound Transit, Community Transit and King County Metro will be adding a new bus stop in front of the project on Beardslee Boulevard by 2024. This new bus stop and the redevelopment will include widening Beardslee Boulevard to two lanes, undergrounding of power lines, creation of a shared bike and pedestrian path, new stormwater system, and incorporation of the transit platform and shelter.
