Committed to no residence hall at the edge of the property line, which mitigated much of the resistance. Air quality and noise analysis are being expanded to respond to comments on the DEIS. Exploring a blending of the “Core” and the “North” sites as a fourth alternative. Included in the CMP: design guidelines, development regulations, parking cap, SOV and housing concerns. Friday, July 7th – Should receive preliminary Final EIS for review. Monday, July 24th – Comments due
