Did you know UW Recycles Styrofoam?

Love it or hate it, Styrofoam is everywhere. UW Recycling provides a Styrofoam recycling program that gives this single-use material a second life!

How to Recycle

For large volumes:

Request Styrofoam bags from the Kane Hall Classroom Installation and Maintenance Team at 206-685-4640 or stop by room 035.

For small volumes:

Use your own clear plastic bags

Then, follow these easy steps:

- 1) Remove all tape and labels. Boxes must be empty, with no contamination (no ice packs, packing peanuts, paper, etc.).
- 2) Collect Styrofoam in bags and securely close.
- 3) Label bag with department name and box number.
- 4) Take bag to your building's loading dock and place by recycling containers.
- 5) Email recycle@uw.edu and let us know Styrofoam is ready for pick-up.
