## Did you know UW Recycles Styrofoam?

*Love it or hate it, Styrofoam is everywhere. UW Recycling provides a Styrofoam recycling program that gives this single-use material a second life!*

### How to Recycle

#### **For large volumes:**

Request Styrofoam bags from the MoES Admin office by emailing [MoES@uw.edu](mailto:MoES@uw.edu)

#### **For small volumes:**

Use your own clear plastic bags

### Then, follow these easy steps:

- 1) Remove all tape and labels. Boxes must be empty, with no contamination (no ice packs, packing peanuts, paper, etc.).
- 2) Collect Styrofoam in bags and securely close.
- 3) Label bag with department/lab name and box number.
- 4) Take bag to your building's loading dock and place by recycling containers.
- 5) Email [recycle@uw.edu](mailto:recycle@uw.edu) and let us know Styrofoam is ready for pick-up.
